If a student is exempted from some required Japanese Language Subjects (①) based on the placement test etc., they must earn the same amount of credits for the "⑤ Language Education and/or Common Liberal Arts Subjects" field instead.

**The number of credits required for graduation.** The total number of required credits for all specified fields is 102. Please earn the remaining 22 required credits in the fields you are interested in.

Completed Credits. The number of credits in ①②③④⑥ cannot exceed the number shown in "Required (adjusted)". (See \*A, B, C)

The credits earned for the required subjects "Introduction to Economics" and "Statistics" will be counted under "② Required Common Liberal Arts Subjects".

\*B  
If a student completes both "Fundamental Mathematics" and "Advanced Mathematics", 2 of the 4 credits will be counted under "③ Required Common Liberal Arts Subjects (Mathematics)" and the remaining 2 credits will be counted under "④ Common Liberal Arts Subjects"

\*C  
If the number of completed credits for "④ Common Liberal Arts Subjects" exceeds 10 credits, then the surplus credits will be counted under "⑤ Language Education and/or Common Liberal Arts Subjects".

\*G  
"Total Credits" means the sum of completed credits from fields ① to ⑧.

\*H  
Japanese-basis domestic students and Accelerated Graduation Program students must complete at least 20 credits of Common Liberal Arts Subjects or Major Education Subjects (either from their own college or another college) held in their non-basis language. All subjects held in both English and Japanese (E/J) and Language Education Subjects will not be counted toward this total.
