1. "Number of Students Enrolled per Full-time Faculty Member" was calculated as follows.

Number of Students Enrolled per Full-time Faculty Member = Current Number of Students (as of May 1, 2021 / (Total Number of Full-time Faculty (A) + the number calculated by dividing the number of faculty members who belong to other undergraduate education organization among college/department based on its student capacity (College of Asia Pacific Studies: 2,712 College of International Management : 2,768 Ratio of Student Capacity = 1:1))

According to the formula defined above, Number of Students Enrolled per Full-time Faculty Member is calculated as follows.

-College of Asia Pacific Studies 2,788/(46+40.5) = (approximately) 32.2-College of International Managemer 2,681/(37+40.5) =(approximately) 34.6
