Gale eBooks provides more than 25,000 titles including Gale's award-winning reference works and excellent titles from over 100 prestigious publishers. Together, the titles cover all academic subjects including the humanities, social sciences, and STEM, and also includes books for general readers and students. Most of these eBooks are made available to APU users as a free trial in October 2023 through the above link.

Although the library will review usage statistics during the trial, together with their selection policy, to consider which titles to purchase, usage of a title will not guarantee its purchase. Gale eBooks' Functions include:

- Listen Tool provides text-to-speech audio and reads aloud any part of the text. The text is highlighted as it is read.
- Translate Tool allows users to translate the text into almost 50 languages including Japanese
- Font Size tool allows users to increase or decrease the text's font size.
- Send Tool allows users to send the document to Google Drive or Microsoft OneDrive. Users can email the document as well.
- Print and Download Tool are available
