

## Screening Information for External Scholarship Recommendations from APU (Term 1, AY2022)

### 【Basic Information】

\* There are external scholarships for which students can apply to APU for a formal recommendation to the foundation awarding the scholarship. Students will first need to apply to APU and undergo an internal screening. APU will recommend students who pass the internal screening to the scholarship foundation and those students will then apply to the foundation itself. Please be aware there is no guarantee you will be selected by the foundation even if you successfully secure a recommendation from APU.

\* Each scholarship has different objectives and requirements. Read both the information below and the application guidelines for each scholarship carefully before applying for the scholarship(s) that match your objectives and for which you meet the requirements. **Be aware that your application will not be screened if you apply for scholarships you are not eligible for.**

\* **Read the [Requirements to Apply for External Scholarship Recommendations from APU] below and check if you meet all the requirements prior to applying.**

\* If you are selected as a scholarship recipient by a scholarship foundation, you are required to communicate with them and become actively involved in their activities. In almost all cases, the language used is Japanese. Therefore, except for a few scholarships that students can apply using only English, **the application guidelines are written in Japanese. Do not apply if you cannot read and understand the guidelines on your own.**

(GSAM Students: International relations is also accepted in the case of students from developing countries where business administration is not an established discipline.)

#### 3. Japanese Language Skills (graduate students only)

As written above, Japanese language ability is required to apply for these scholarships. Applicants' Japanese language skills will be assessed in the internal screening.

Seeing as Japanese language courses are not mandatory for graduate students, the University will only accept applications from graduate students who went to school in Japan or have studied Japanese and possess Japanese language skills equivalent to the N3 level of the Japanese Language Proficiency Test (JLPT) except for scholarships that students can apply for in English. Please contact the Student Office if you have studied Japanese but have never taken the JLPT and are unsure whether your abilities are equivalent to an N3 level.

#### 4. Other

(1) The following students are not eligible to apply:

- Students whose lack of morals and/or impaired sense of responsibility make them unsuitable scholarship candidates.
- Students who do not comply with university regulations. This includes not getting a periodic health checkup or going for a re-exam or detailed exam if required. (Not necessary in AY2020 and 2021 unless a health certificate is required by the scholarship foundation.)
- Students who have already been selected for another scholarship that does not permit recipients to receive additional scholarships, or who have applied for such a scholarship.
- Students who do not meet the requirements of the scholarship(s) they are applying for.

(2) Your status as a candidate or scholarship recipient will be revoked in the following cases:

- False statements found in application documents and/or during the interview.
- Behavior that breaches the conditions of the scholarship, such as behavior that results in disciplinary action from the University.
- Not complying with university regulations. This includes not getting a periodic health checkup or going for a re-exam or detailed exam if required.

### 【Screening Process for External Scholarship Recommendations from APU】

(1) First Screening: Document Screening (survey)

- Enter all the required information in the survey. You have successfully submitted your application when the completion message appears on the screen.
- Applications will not be accepted after the deadline regardless of the reason. The Student Office will not respond to questions concerning whether an applicant's survey has been successfully submitted or not.
- The survey can only be submitted once. Applications will be automatically rejected if an applicant attempts to resubmit it a second time.
